

Coming from Antwerpen - Mechelen (E19) or Liège - Leuven - Zaventem (E40): follow the Ring-Road RO, direction "Gent". Take exit 7 bis and follow the road signs to "Strombeek - Bever".

## How to reach P&G by public transport:

From train station Noordstation/Gare du Nord: take <u>bus 251 (Brussel-Steenhuffel-Londerzeel-Puurs</u>) until you reach <u>bus-stop Madelon</u> (+/- 30 minutes). You then arrive at the Romeinse Steenweg/Chaussée Romaine. Cross the street and take the first side-street (= a very small street called Temselaan).

From train station Noordstation/Gare du Nord: take <u>tram 52</u> to <u>Esplanade</u> – <u>Drogenbos</u> (Station Laken Esplanande). When leaving this station, you will need to take the bridge to cross the A12. Go downstairs at the end of the bridge; you are now in the Avenue de Madridlaan. Cross the Romeinse Steenweg/Chaussée Romaine at the traffic lights. You are now in the Boechoutlaan and will see P&G on your left hand side (take the second street at your left).

2. From train station Centraal station/Gare Centrale: take the metro to Heysel (line 1A direction Koning Boudewijn/Roi Baudouin) (+/-25 minutes). When leaving the Heysel metro station, you will see different palaces of the Heysel in front of you. Trum right and walk straight on (the trade center is on your right as well). When you arrive at the end of the Esplanadestraat, take left. Cross the Romeinse Steenweg/Chaussée Romaine at the traffic lights. You are now in the Boechoutlaan, P&G is on your left hand side (take the second street at your left).

Another possibility is to take the Minibus shuttle that stops at the Heysel metro station. It will take you to P&C! From Heysel to P&C: at 7.15 am, 7.35 am, 7.55 am, 8.15 am, 8.35 am, 8.55 am and 9.15

am. From P&G to Heysel: at 4.00 pm, 4.20 pm, 4.40 pm, 5.00 pm, 5.20 pm, 5.40 pm, 6.00 pm.

3. From train station Mechelen station/station of Mechelen: take the <u>bus 280</u> (Mechelen-Verbrande Brug) until you reach bus-stop Vilvoorde station (+/- 30 minutes). When you arrive at bus-stop Vilvoorde station you will have to take <u>bus 320</u> (Zaventem-Jette) until you reach <u>bus-stop Madelon</u> (+/- 30 minutes). You then arrive at the Romeinse Steenweg/Chaussée Romaine. Cross the street and take the first side-street (= a very small street called Temselaan).









- 4. From Brussels Airport at Zaventem: take <u>bus 820</u> (Zavent-Jette) until you reach busstop Madelon (+/- 30 minutes). You then arrive at the Romeinse Steenweg/Chaussée Romaine. Cross the street and take the first side-street (= a very small street called Temselaan).
- From train station Vilvoorde station: take <u>bus 820</u> (Zaventem-Jette) until you reach busstop Madelon (+/- 30 minutes). You then arrive at the Romeinse Steenweg/Chaussée Romaine. Cross the street and take the first side-street (= a very small street called Temselaan).
- 6. From train station Gent Sint-Pieters: take the train <u>De Panne Landen</u> or <u>Blankenberge Tongeren</u> (+/- 40 minutes) until you reach <u>Brussel Noordstation/Gare du Nord.</u> There you take bus <u>bus 250</u> (<u>Brussel-Londerzeel-Liezele-Puurs</u>) until you reach <u>bus-stop Madelon</u> (+/- 30 minutes). You then arrive at the Romeinse Steenweg/Chaussée Romaine. Cross the street and take the first side-street (= a very small street called Temselaan).
