- Identify specific short-term actions to get to next steps for the Physical Internet realization.

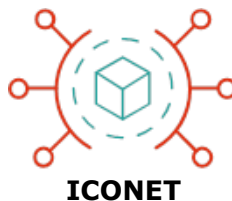
Audience
