



## **Launch event of ALICE-Hydrogen Europe collaboration**

Joining forces to help decarbonise road transport logistics.

## **Summary:**

A 90% reduction in transport emissions is needed by 2050 to meet the Green Deal ambitions of carbon neutrality. This will require strong and ambitious commitments from all forces. This is the background of the collaboration between Hydrogen Europe and the ALICE platform, formalised by a Memorandum of Understanding signed on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020.

Both associations recognise that hydrogen solutions for transport and logistics are key to achieve Europe's sustainable objectives. To accelerate the uptake of the technologies, strong collaboration and mutual understanding are needed among stakeholders across the whole value chain to understand and overcome potential barriers and/or propose solutions to address them.

This event marks this collaboration's launch to prepare the ground, explain what is at stake, and look at how the different hydrogen-based technologies fit into the big picture of decarbonisation. Presentations from well-known consultancies will illustrate this.

This event is an exciting opportunity to learn about the potential of hydrogen technologies in the road transport logistics sector from a short term and long-term perspective.
