




COFRET — Research project

2011-2014

- Primary focus was GHG emission calculation tool development
 - Rejected by advisory board once project was underway
- Primary project outputs
 - Scientific review of existing calculation methodologies
 - Strong industry network with vision for the future → concrete exploitation plan
 - ISO International agreement: sowing the seeds for future development
- SFC initiated the GLEC with COFRET advisory board within project extension period
 - Industry engagement at global level
 - Clear goal, work program and support funding

- 2014 Launch of the Global Logistics Emissions Council (GLEC)
- 2015 Consultations and development of the GLEC Framework
- 2016 Launch of the GLEC Framework 1.0






The LEARN Project — Networking project 2016-2019










- Following of the new ISO 14083 further market expansion expected
