# BOOSTLOG data sharing cloud report

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
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- **collaboration between the key players in the sector** – manufacturers, suppliers, logistics services providers, carriers, warehouses etc. **relies on data**
- according to a recent study by PwC *“there is no other industry where so many industry experts ascribe a **high importance to data sharing and analytics in the next five years than transportation and logistics** – 90% in T&L compared to an average of 83%*
- multiple international standards organizations are trying to identify a **normalized method of identification of required data that will apply to any seller to buyer shipment, regardless of the transport mode.**

## Data sharing definition:

*Data sharing in a supply chain is referred to as the extent to which crucial and/or proprietary information is available to other actors of the supply chain for the completion of their daily operations*

- On 17 May 2018 the Commission adopted a proposal for regulating electronic freight transport information
- The proposal was part of the third ‘Europe on the move’ package, which followed the 2016 low-emission mobility strategy and the two mobility packages of May and November 2017 related to industrial policy strategy and contributes to the objective of a safe, clean and efficient mobility.
- On 6 June 2019 the Council announced that all relevant public authorities would be **required** to accept information made available electronically on **certified platforms** when companies use this format to provide information
- ***The final act was published in the Official Journal of the EU on 31 July 2020 and entered into force 20 August 2020***
- The eFTI regulation (No 2020/1056) shall ***apply from 21 August 2024***



- Reduced administrative costs in transport and logistics – **27 Billion euro over 20 years**
- Improved overall efficiency of the logistics chain, as it will also facilitate the electronic exchange of information between the economic operators themselves
- More efficient enforcement of freight transport rules in the Union
- Complementary effects with the European Maritime Single Window Environment and the EU Single Window Environment for Customs
