






# What is ALICE Liaison Program






#### Context of this PI Webinar



- Physical Internet (PI): local, national and international projects/initiatives.
- complexity at many levels throughout the supply chain,
  - interoperable systems and business solutions are necessary
- PI network layers, service layers and intranets (local living labs).
- One's last gateway (where flows end) is the first gateway (where flows start) of another company.





# PI Webinar Objectives



- Introduce physical internet architectures and their applicability via use cases
- Discuss how synergies can be leveraged across projects
- What data/information would need to be shared, and how could messaging, semantic technology (i.e., Web3.0) and other approaches help
