


Modernisation of the TEN-T

Innovation Fund



CALLS 2022-2023 programme

 The Innovation Fund - around EUR 38 billion of support from 2020 to 2030 (at EUR 75/ tCO2) for the commercial demonstration of innovative low-carbon technologies, aiming to bring to the market solutions to decarbonise Europe and support its transition to climate neutrality.

Production and use of Renewable energy including manufacturing plants for components

Carbon Capture Use and Storage

Scaling up clean tech

Energy-intensive industries

including substitute products

Energy storage

CINEA current IF portfolio - 37 projects (total grants of around €1.25 billion). Additional 17 large-scale projects (of around €1.8 billion) are currently under GAP.

- Some examples of road transport related projects:
 - Production and use of alternative **fuels** in the road transport sector (hydrogen, electricity, biofuels, synthetic fuels etc.)
 - Transport of alternative fuels (e.g. hydrogen) or CO2 via road transport
 - Innovative energy storage technologies, such as Vehicle-to-Grid

Co-funding of up to €400 Mio (2020-2026)

EIT Urban Mobility Annual Innovation Call for Proposals

- ✓ Better mobility services for citizens, higher levels of accessibility, reduction in greenhouse gas emissions, and better use of urban space
- ✓ Solutions should contribute to city services integration, helping cities implementing their own policies
- ✓ Medium sized consortia
- ✓ Market-based and solution-oriented. TRL > 6
- ✓ Pathways for SME's to expand and grow
- ✓ Centred on pan-European demonstration and testing in real-life contexts with public engagement
- ✓ 12 to 18 months duration

EIC Accelerator looks for:

- ✓ Start-ups and SMEs seeking to scale up high impact innovations with the potential to create new markets or disrupt existing ones
- ✓ Innovations building on scientific discovery or technological breakthroughs ("deep tech")
- ✓ Innovations where significant funding is needed over a long timeframe and are too risky for private investors alone
