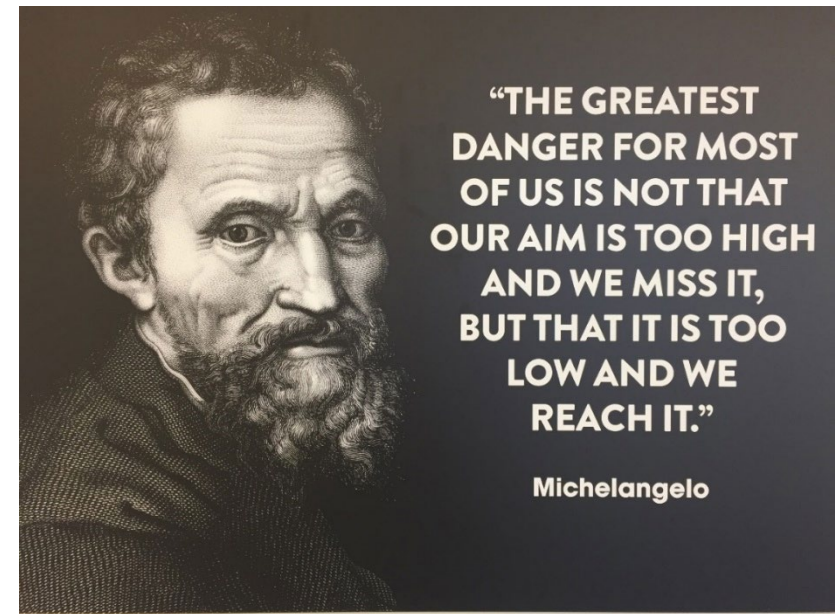
- Host technical visits at your locations where you are deploying (or would like to deploy) autonomous and connected solutions

- Invite ALICE members to visit EINRIDE event(s) and share best practices
- Arrange site visits to logistics sites to gain a better understanding of the interest, constraints and potential motivation for transitioning to autonomous solutions
- Visit sites and events of relevant R&I projects: e.g. AWARD, MODI, ULTIMO
- Provide continuous feedback to key stakeholders (EC, CCEM, ERTICO, POLIS...) from the logistics industry perspective
